

# COURSES OF FIRE

## COURSE #1

TARGET: I.D.P.A. Combat

DISTANCE (yd)	TIME (sec)	ROUNDS

\* Strong hand only, mandatory reload

\*\*Weak hand only

All firing is done from the standing position. Start position: Standing erect with hands in surrender position above the shoulders with the firearm holstered.

## COURSE #2

TARGET: I.D.P.A. Combat (Covered with a T-shirt)

DISTANCE (yd)	TIME (sec)	ROUNDS
25	15	6 rounds, standing
15	15	6 rounds, standing or kneeling
15	10	6 rounds, standing
10	10	6 rounds, standing
5*	4	6 rounds, standing, two hand
5*	4	6 rounds, standing, left hand only
5*	4	6 rounds, standing, right hand only

TOTAL RDS 42

**\*5 yd line start with firearm drawn at a 45 degree down angle**

All firing for course # 2 is done from the standing position. Starting position: Standing erect with hands in surrender position above the shoulders (with the exception of the 5 yard line).

## COURSE #3 (STEEL)

16 Steel Plates (various sizes and shapes) will be vary from 15 yards to 25 yards from the shooter. On the start signal shooter will pick up firearm from the shooting bench, and knock down all plates (random order). Shooter must reload his firearm once prior to hitting the last plate. Score will be determined by taking the total time used to knock the plates down with reload, and subtracting that from 100 points. Plates must fall to count. Time will be kept by a Pocket Pro Timer, or similar device, that audibly records total shooting time. Firearm and all spare ammunition will start on the shooting bench. Shooter will start standing erect with hands in surrender position.

**Minimum number of handgun rounds required for match: recommend 120 or higher**

A hip holster that has a retaining device is required (no cross-draws or shoulder holsters permitted). Pouches for speed devices/magazines is highly recommended.

All participants are required to bring a T-Shirt that will be used on course # 2.

## COURSE # 4 (SHOTGUN – Steel & Clays)

Course will be a 20 shot course combining steel plates and clay birds. Shells containing no larger than 7 ½ shot may be used. Firearm must be capable of hold 4 shells and have a barrel no longer than 28” and choked no tighter than I/C. Scoring is total number of hits. Course specifics are still being refined and will be available the day of the match.

# Duty Division

Any centerfire 5" barrel autos, or shorter or 4" barrel revolvers, or shorter (no compensators, or porting). No add on magazine-well funnels. No external modifications that have dramatically changed the firearm. Any questions in reference to "modifications" must be answered before you shoot! Holsters must have at least one (1) mechanical release for retention. Friction style holsters will not qualify.

# Open Division

Any centerfire firearm with any barrel length and modifications, no optics allowed. Holster restrictions do not apply, however, firearms must be holstered while on the line.

# Match Rules

1. Match Director's decision is final in all matters. Match Director is Jeff Herrman.
2. Unsafe firearm handling will result in disqualification.
3. Breaking a 90 degree plane with the muzzle of the firearm will result in disqualification.
4. Any dropped firearm will result in disqualification.
5. No handling of firearms off the firing line other than in designated safe areas.
6. All firearms will be unloaded at all times. Range Masters will give specific instructions as to when the firearms are to be loaded.
7. Anyone discovering a safety problem will report it to a Range Master immediately.
8. All rounds will be fired in such a manner that they will impact the berm.
9. Hearing and eye protection is mandatory for all persons on or near the firing line.
10. Shooters are required to wear a brimmed hat while competing.
11. Holsters will be strong side only. No cross draw, or shoulder holsters. Holsters must hold the firearm securely. (Special restrictions for duty division.)
12. No tracer, or armor piercing ammunition. Ammunition must not damage the metal targets.
13. Specific individual rules and restrictions will apply to each match event.

**All firearms will be subjected to a "safety inspection" prior to use on the range.**

**Your registration fee will be used to purchase targets, T-Shirts and trophies. All remaining money will be donated to the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Program for use in the following counties in North Central Missouri:**

**Door Prizes will be awarded randomly**

**Trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place for the Duty & Open Divisions handgun only), 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place 2 gun (combined) score and to the highest women's handgun scorer.**
